

## ACCESS TRANSPORTATION AND THE UC/METRO FARE CARD

- All eligible UC Students and Employees can register for a UC/Metro Fare Card online at: <https://www.uc.edu/af/facilities/metro/> and pay the \$40 Student or \$120 Employee charge online with a credit or debit card. Once registered, Metro will process your registration and MAIL a UC/Metro Fare Card to the address you indicate on your registration page.
- **SPECIAL NOTE FOR UC Student/Employee ACCESS RIDERS:** To receive your supply of yellow Access transportation tickets, you must do the following:
  1. Comply with Access's routine process to establish eligibility to use Access transportation (<http://www.go-metro.com/access.html>).
  2. Register online and pay online for the UC/Metro Card <https://www.uc.edu/af/facilities/metro/>, and, once that is completed,
  3. Send an email to these two Metro employees: Terri Andrews ([tandrews@go-metro.com](mailto:tandrews@go-metro.com)) AND copy Darryl Haley ([dhaley@go-metro.com](mailto:dhaley@go-metro.com)) and tell them you have:
    - A.) registered for a UC/Metro Card, and
    - B.) would like to receive yellow Access ride tickets, and
    - C.) provide them with an address where they may mail your supply of yellow Access ride tickets.
- The Autumn 09 UC/Metro Fare Card will cover the cost of the current \$1.50 Zone 1 fare for travel on both Metro buses and Access vehicles.
- As of Sept 23, 2009, UC Students and Employees are required to pay the difference between the Zone 1 fare (currently \$1.50) and the appropriate Zone charge for the zone in which they ride, whether that ride is on Metro buses or on Access vehicles.
- As of Sept 23, 2009, all UC Students and Employees are also required to show their UC photo ID to the driver at the time they use their UC/Metro Fare Card.
- The UC/Metro Fare Card for Autumn Quarter 2009 is valid from Sept 23 (first day of Autumn 09 classes) up to and including Jan 3, 2010 (which is the day before the first day of Winter 10 classes). Its use is unlimited per day during its validation period. The card is only for the individual it is issued to; it may not be used by anyone else.
- To make use of the UC/Metro Fare subsidy, eligible UC Students and Employees must register online and pay online for a UC/Metro Fare Card for each Academic Term.

### **HOW TO USE THE UC/METRO FARE CARD WHEN RIDING ACCESS TRANSPORTATION:**

To use the UC/Metro Fare Card from September 23, 2009 going forward, Access riders must:

- 1.) present your ACCESS-issued ID, AND
- 2.) present your yellow Access ride ticket, AND
- 3.) present your UC/Metro Fare Card to the Access driver, AND
- 4.) present your UC photo ID to the Access driver, AND
- 5.) pay the additional Zone Charge of \$0.50, if you travel in Zone 2 (This is normally a \$2.00 fare; minus the \$1.50 Zone 1 subsidy provided through the UC/Metro Fare Card equates to a \$0.50 charge.)
