SHUTTLE BUS RIDERS**

Snow or ice storms may result in hazardous driving conditions that make it necessary to suspend the shuttle bus operations. With winter weather approaching, you should develop contingency travel plans in case the shuttle bus operations are suspended with little advance notice. This may occur even though classes remain in session and the University of Cincinnati remains open.



As an alternative, there are Metro routes near the College of Applied Science (CAS) that will take you to the vicinity of UC's Main Campus. Because Metro buses are much larger vehicles than the shuttle bus, they usually continue to operate during snow emergencies. If a decision is made to suspend operations, the CAS shuttle bus will make one last trip to the College of Applied Science. The shuttle will wait 10 minutes at CAS to allow time for riders to board it before departing for the last return trip to Main Campus. The CAS Office of Student Services will be notified of suspended shuttle bus operations and they will display a message on the scrolling electronic sign or other information screens to alert shuttle bus riders to this service disruption.
