

MET Computer Account Application and Policies

- All MET students must apply for a MET roaming profile computer account. All roaming profiles include 1GB of storage space and can be accessed from any MET lab and the 4th floor CAS general computing lab.
- Students are responsible for reading the IT Resources and Student Usage Guidelines as well as the Student Code of Conduct found at:

- Students are responsible for reporting hardware and/or software problems to the MET Network Administrator, Sam Antoline, CAS Admin 605.
- Students are responsible for backing up and saving their work often on personal storage devices.
- Print jobs are limited to 20 pages and one copy of a document. Larger jobs (printing a solutions manual or book) must be performed elsewhere.
- The use of food, drink, and/or tobacco products is not permitted in the MET computer labs. Anyone doing so will be asked to leave and may be held responsible for any damages to equipment.
- Game playing in the lab is prohibited and the game may be terminated by a lab consultant, professor, or MET Network Administrator without notice.
- Viewing and/or downloading pornography is prohibited and will result in the loss of computer privileges and disciplinary action.
- Students are prohibited from installing software on any lab computer without permission from the MET Network Administrator. Students doing so risk expulsion from the labs, their major, and possibly the University of Cincinnati.
- The use file sharing programs (Morpheus, Kazaa, Bitorrent, etc...) is prohibited and will result in the loss of computer privileges.
- Any student caught launching "hacker" attacks, writing worms or viruses, or installing malicious or damaging software is subject to immediate expulsion from the University of Cincinnati and Civil or Criminal Prosecution.
