

Make the transition.



Special transition agreements have been developed with five of UC's colleges. In addition to the successful completion of your Learning Agreement, admission criteria for these colleges (as listed below) must be met.

- **McMicken College of Arts and Science (A&S)**
Maintain a GPA of 2.0 or higher for transition to all degree programs.

- **College of Allied Health Science (CAHS)**
Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher for transition to all degree programs.

- **College of Applied Science (CAS)**
Maintain a GPA of 2.75 or higher for transition to all baccalaureate degree programs.

Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher for transition to all associate degree programs.

If you are making progress and have the recommendation of your advisor, you may be considered for conditional acceptance even though you do not meet the above criteria.

- **College of Education, Criminal Justice and Human Services (CECH)**
Maintain a GPA of 2.75 or higher for admission to all teacher education programs.

Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher for transition to all other undergraduate degree programs.

- **College of Nursing (NUR)**
Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher for admission to the pre-nursing program, and have completed 42 MATH 092 with a grade of "C" or higher, prior to enrolling in Statistics for Health Sciences.

Some CAT students have also been accepted into the College of Business; the College Conservatory of Music; the College of Design, Art, Architecture and Planning and the School of Social Work. Admission to these colleges is highly competitive. Students interested in these possibilities must notify their advisor early in the process and work closely with them to create an alternate pathway.
