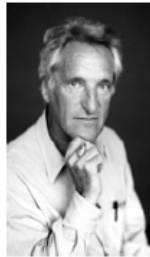

Mr. Van der Ryn is a renowned leader in sustainable architecture. For over 35 years, his design, planning, teaching and public leadership has advanced the acceptance of ecological principles in architecture and planning. The theme of Sim's career in design, teaching and research has been applying principles of physical and social ecology to architecture and environmental design. He has designed single family and multi-family housing; community facilities; retreat, resort and health centers; schools and learning facilities; office buildings; commercial buildings; and planned communities. In each project, he has pioneered new technologies, systems, materials and design solutions to create environments that are sensitive to place and climate, responsive to human needs and that place the highest regard on both the integrity of ecological systems and the quality of life.
