

Directions for AWC Tutor Feedback

AWC Tutor Feedback is a service that allows all UC Students to submit their paper of six double-spaced pages or less to the Academic Writing Center. Within 24-48 hours (slightly longer on the weekends), you will receive your paper back from the AWC with points of helpful feedback.

Follow these steps to use the service!

1. Get Your Paper Ready!

Be sure that your paper is ready for submission. We do have rules in place regarding what type of papers can be submitted. For instance, we have a six double-spaced page limit. Additionally, we prefer clean copies of papers (so feedback should not already be present). Most important, AWC Tutor Feedback is not an editing service, so papers that merely require editing are not eligible (so proofread your paper).

We're always ready to help students, but papers that do not follow our requirements may be sent back.

2. Go to the AWC Website and Click the Button!

AWC Online Tutoring Programs

The Academic Writing Center has two new online tutoring programs for students: AWC Online and AWC Tutor Feedback. These two programs are accessible for all UC students, so see which one works best for you.



AWC Online

AWC Online allows students to video conference with AWC Tutors and work on their papers online and in real-time. First, schedule an AWC Online appointment with a tutor. Next, submit your paper via the AWC Online form. Then, at your scheduled time, conference with a tutor through Google Hangouts.

AWC Tutor Feedback

AWC Tutor Feedback allows students to submit drafts of their essays to AWC tutors and receive helpful feedback. To access the service, just simply submit your paper via the AWC Tutor Feedback form. Within 24-48 hours, an AWC tutor will email the essay and feedback to you.

3. Fill Out the Form and Submit Your Paper!

AWC Tutor Feedback

Welcome to AWC Tutor Feedback! This service allows you to submit a paper of six double-spaced pages or less to the Academic Writing Center where one of our tutors will read it, provide feedback, and submit it back to you within 24-48 hours (weekend turnaround time may be longer).

Please keep in mind that AWC Tutor Feedback is not an editing service. Although we will provide feedback regarding grammar and sentence structure, we will primarily be focusing on organization, clarity, and content. Additionally, papers may be sent back with no feedback under the following conditions:

- Your paper is longer than six double-spaced pages.
- Your paper already has extensive feedback from a professor or classmate. Therefore, please submit a clean copy.
- Your paper has extensive grammatical issues in which case a face-to-face appointment would be more suitable. Please proofread your paper beforehand.

Lastly, fill out the submission form in its entirety. This will assist the tutor in reviewing your paper. Some important things of note: (1) Be sure you put in a proper email as that is where the feedback will be sent. (2) Definitely provide the tutor with as much information regarding the assignment as possible. (3) Be specific in what assistance you want (again, do not just write “fix my grammar.”) (4) Be sure you attach your paper at the bottom of the form.

When you press the “submit form” button you should receive an email confirmation that we have received your paper. Within 24-48hrs, you will receive an email from awc@uc.edu with your paper and feedback attached.
