She has extensive experience working with underrepresented populations in the mental health, education, and non-profit arenas. Dy'an has been invited speaker at local, national, and international conferences where she has presented her research on creating inclusive classrooms, advancing cultural sensitivity among counselors-in-training, and increasing diversity, equity, and inclusion among students, faculty, and staff in higher education. Currently, Dy'an is the Program Coordinator in the Office of Equity & Inclusion. With a BS in Criminal Justice and MA in Mental Health Counseling, Dy'an entered doctoral candidacy in the UC Counseling Program in 2016. She expects to receive her Doctorate in Counselor Education in 2017.
