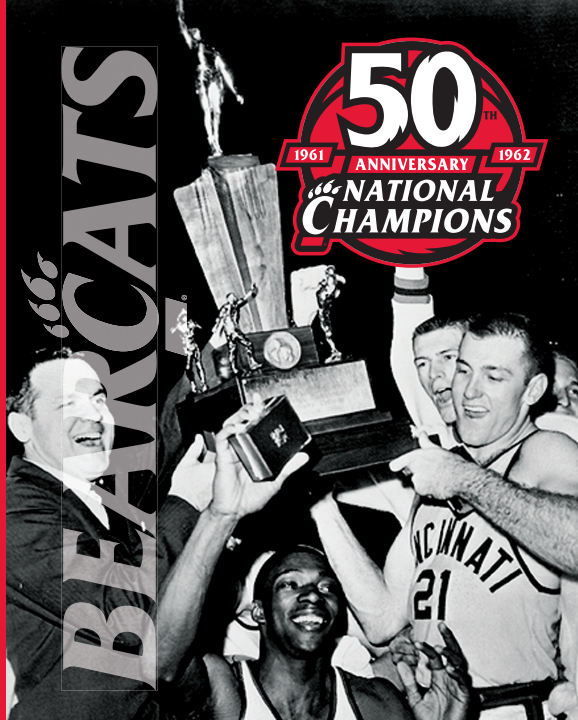
▶ UC fields **18 varsity teams** — 10 for women and 8 for men — and competes in the **BIG EAST Conference**.
