Services: International Students & Scholars

UC International Services is committed to serving the needs of international visitors who come to the University of Cincinnati and the departments who sponsor them. Our responsibilities include:

- Advising international visitors (students, scholars, faculty and professional employees) on immigration, tax and visa matters
- Coordinating special events and programs for international visitors
- Developing and organizing educational programs designed to integrate international visitors into all aspects of campus and community life
- Advising and instructing University personnel on policies and procedures related to bringing international visitors to campus, including conducting workshops and seminars specific to student and non-student visits/employment/permanent residence/taxation
- Serving as liaison between the University and government agencies, such as the Department of Homeland Security, the Department of Labor, the United States Department of State, and the Internal Revenue Service, to ensure that the University is in compliance with federal regulations

Note: International students enrolled for fall 2016 represent 7.7% of UC's total student body enrollment. Overall international enrollment has increased by 63% since 2010. Students on Optional Practical Training represent a significant growing population with 835 students currently in the US on OPT compared to 277 students in 2010. This represents a 201% increase over that time period.
