## Important Information:

- Exam takes about 4.5 hours and is offered year-round through Prometric test centers.
- \$510 fee If a student selects at least one ADEA/AADSAS or TMDSAS school at the time of <u>DAT registration</u>, scores will be sent to all AADSAS and/or TMDSAS schools. If no school is selected, there is a \$45 fee per school to have your score report sent. It is strongly recommended to choose at least one school when registering to avoid the additional cost. Fee Waiver information.
- Test scores range from 1-30, average scores of accepted students at Ohio schools is 20-21.
- Unofficial test scores and explanation are received immediately upon completion of DAT. Official scores will be released to schools 3-4 weeks after test date.
- Examinees must wait 90 days between testing attempts. Those who have tested three or more times must apply for special permission to take the test again. It is recommended that you take the test at least one year before you want to go to dental school.
