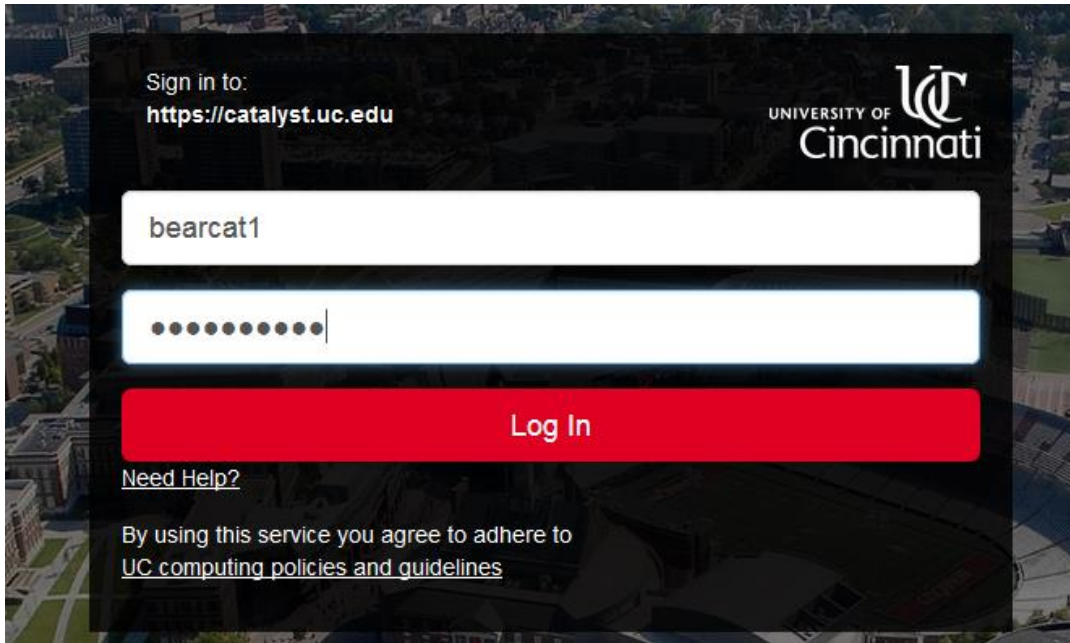
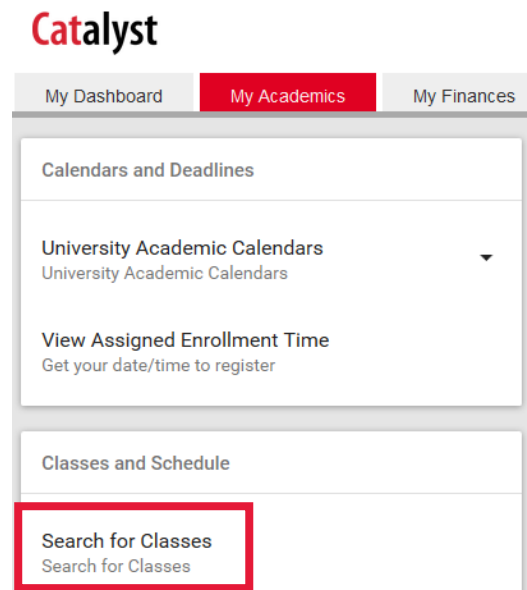
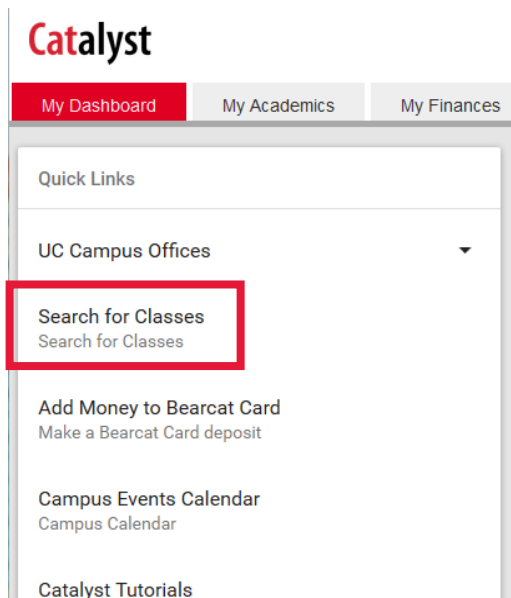


SEARCHING FOR CLASSES IN CATALYST
