University of Cincinnati graduate students living in several nearby Kentucky counties are able to attend UC at an established metropolitan tuition rate. This graduate metropolitan rate equals Ohio in-state tuition plus \$100 per quarter for full-time graduate students (up to 18 credit hours per quarter); Ohio in-state tuition plus \$1500 per quarter for Pharmacy (Pharm. D.) students (up to 18 credit hours per quarter); Ohio in-state tuition plus \$120 per semester for full-time Law (JD) students (up to 18 credit hours per quarter semester); and Ohio in-state tuition plus \$120 per quarter for full-time Medicine (MD) students (up to 24 credit hours per quarter). The metropolitan rate for part-time graduate students and overload credit hours is in-state tuition plus \$10 per graduate credit hour and in-state tuition plus \$150 per credit hour for Pharmacy (Pharm. D.) students.

With the exception of the UC College of Law LLM Program, all University of Cincinnati graduate and professional degree programs are offering the graduate metropolitan rate. Students pursuing the College of Law LLM Program *are not* eligible for the graduate metropolitan rate.

If you are *financially independent*, you must supply documents establishing that you are a legal and physical resident of an eligible Kentucky county (e.g., driver's license or state I.D., and current lease). If you are the *financial dependent* of a parent/legal guardian who is a resident of an eligible Kentucky county, you must submit: 1) the parent/legal guardian's most recent federal tax return naming you as a financial dependent; and 2) documents establishing that the parent/legal guardian is a legal and physical resident of an eligible Kentucky county (e.g., driver's license or state I.D., and current lease).

Documentation of eligibility should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the start of the term for which you are enrolling, but no later than the first day of classes for that term. Documentation received after the start of the term will be processed for the following term. Faxed copies will not be accepted. The Registrar's Office may require additional documentation prior to making a determination regarding your metro rate eligibility.
