Undergraduate residents of specified counties in Kentucky are able to attend University of Cincinnati at a metropolitan tuition rate.

With the exception of all College of Design, Architecture, Art and Planning programs, the metropolitan rate is applicable to all other undergraduate and certificate programs. For new and continuing students, the metropolitan rate is the Ohio in-state tuition rate plus \$10.00 per credit hour each quarter to a maximum of a \$120.00 surcharge (12 to 18 hours per quarter).

Note: Effective with Autumn Quarter 2011 applications, Fayette County, KY residents will be eligible to apply for the undergraduate metropolitan rate.

If you are *financially independent*, you must supply documents establishing that you are a legal and physical resident of an eligible Kentucky county (e.g., driver's license or state I.D., and current lease). If you are the *financial dependent* of a parent/legal guardian who is a resident of an eligible Kentucky county, you must submit: 1) the parent/legal guardian's most recent federal tax return naming you as a financial dependent; and 2) documents establishing that the parent/legal guardian is a legal and physical resident of an eligible Kentucky county (e.g., driver's license or state I.D., and current lease).

Documentation of eligibility should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the start of the term for which you are enrolling, but no later than the first day of classes for that term. Documentation received after the start of the term will be processed for the following term. Faxed copies will not be accepted. The Registrar's Office may require additional documentation prior to making a determination regarding your metro rate eligibility.

Students approved for the metropolitan rate who change programs *from* an eligible program *to* a College of Design, Architecture, Art and Planning program **are subject to the assessment of out-of state tuition rates.**

Note: undergraduate students from selected nearby counties in Kentucky who are pursuing selected undergraduate programs are eligible for in-state tuition under the Kentucky Reciprocity agreement. You are strongly encouraged to review the eligibility requirements for Kentucky Reciprocity prior to applying for the metropolitan rate. If you believe that you are eligible for Kentucky Reciprocity, apply for Kentucky Reciprocity rather than for the metropolitan rate.
