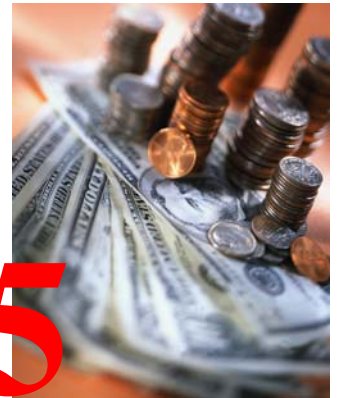
Suicide and Bullying Increase
