**CAS/COE Collegiate Re-Structuring Subcommittee Meeting Outcomes**

The subcommittee on Chemical Technology recommended that Chemical Technology and Culinary Arts move to the NC. Horticulture should go elsewhere. We accepted that recommendation.

We recommend that the name for the NC be “College of Engineering and Applied Science.”

We formed a subcommittee consisting of a faculty representative of each department in COE plus a representative of Engineering Education, a faculty representative of each department in CAS that will be moving to the NC, and an associate dean from each college. This subcommittee is charged with formulating general recommendations for an interim structure for the NC and a process for moving from the interim structure to a final structure.

We formed a second subcommittee consisting of the BA’s from CAS, COE, and A&S and chaired by Kathy Qualls, to discuss how best to divide the budget of CAS and a timeline for doing so that would be least disruptive.

We will ask the restructuring steering committee to decide where the CAS units that are not going to the NC should go, as this information will inform the budget discussion. We will also ask the Provost when we might learn who the dean of the NC will be, as that could inform the interim structure deliberations.

We will meet in two weeks time to hear progress reports from these two subcommittees.
