

SUMMARY OF REGIONAL CAMPUSES DISCUSSED IN THE PROVOST'S LETTER
(KENT STATE, MIAMI U., OHIO U., OHIO STATE)

Kent State

7 Regional Campuses – Report to Sr. VP & Provost, but have an Interim Exec. Director of RCs

Dean on each campus, except East Liverpool and Salem (one Dean for both). Both campuses in Columbiana County, 20 miles apart, East Liverpool = 964 students, Salem = 1,319 students.

Departmental Reporting = Main Campus Department

Course Scheduling = Area Coordinators (no department chairs).

RPT = Main Campus Department (Possibly reverting back to RPT at RC). Tenure resides in Regional Campus system only (can request a dual appointment)

Workload = 12 credit hours per term

Miami University

2 Regional Campuses – Report to Provost

Dean on each campus. Middletown = 2,700 U and 300 G students, Hamilton, 3,800 students.

Departmental Reporting = Main Campus Department A & S Faculty and Regional Campus Department Technical Faculty

Course Scheduling = Main Campus Department and Regional Campus Department Chair

RPT = Main Campus Department

Workload = 12 credit hours per semester

Ohio University

5 Regional Campuses – Report to Executive Dean for Regional Campuses. 2 “Centers” with Directors.

Dean on each campus. Chillicothe = 2,000 students, Lancaster = 1,700 students

Departmental Reporting = Main Campus Department, Tenure resides with the University

Course Scheduling = Main Campus Department and Regional Campus Division Chair

RPT = Main Campus Department

Workload = 12 credit hours per quarter.

Ohio State

4 Regional Campuses – Report to Exec. VP & Provost

Dean on each campus. Lima = 1,200 U and 100 G students, Newark = 2,500 U students

Departmental Reporting = Main Campus Department, Tenure resides with the University per Gordon

Course Scheduling = Assistant Dean or Regional Campus Area Coordinator

RPT = Main Campus Department

Workload = 6 credit hours per quarter per Gordon (no technical or associate degree programs on the Marion Campus). 12 credit hours at Newark for Economics/Statistics faculty.

University of Cincinnati

2 Regional Campuses – RWC = 4,000 students, Clermont = 3,000 students
