\$1,000 and \$500 Scholarships for Spring '10 Semester

Eligibility Criteria

The scholarship is simple: applicants must answer the question "If I had \$1,000,000, how would I change the world?" The students with the best answers, as judged by Athena Study Abroad, will be awarded the scholarships.

Scholarship Amounts

- 1) \$1,000 scholarship toward standard tuition fees of any Athena Study Abroad program for the Spring 2010 semester.
- 2) \$500 scholarship toward standard tuition fees of any Athena Study Abroad program for the Spring 2010 semester.

Note: Locations include Sydney, Australia; Paros Island, Greece; Florence, Italy; Rome, Italy; Tuscany, Italy; Venice, Italy; London, England; Tour of Italy (3 cities, 1 semester).

Number Available

One (1) \$1,000 scholarship and one (1) \$500 scholarship will be awarded for the Spring 2010 semester to Cincinnati students.

Selection Criteria

- Limited to college students currently enrolled at Cincinnati
- Eligible students must be accepted into one of Athena's SP10 semester programs
- Must have a GPA above 2.80
- Must submit a 250 word essay answering the question:
 - If I had \$1,000,000 how would I change the world?
