

Education Abroad Timeline

Before You Apply: (4-6 months in advance)

- Visit UC International to research programs
www.uc.edu/global
- Check with UC International Programs about grant opportunities and financial aid
- Meet with Academic Advisors to discuss course credit
- Apply to chosen program

After Acceptance: (1-3 months in advance)

- Notify UC International Programs of acceptance and turn in Academic Advisor Approval Form
- Apply for a Globalization Grant or other scholarships
- Register for appropriate Study Abroad course (15MLTI300 or 15MLTI500)
- Obtain Passport and visa (if necessary)

- Schedule a Pre-Departure Orientation with your Education Abroad Advisor
- Purchase your International Student ID Card at UC International (\$22 and passport size photo)
- Book Airfare
- Check about health abroad – see your doctor and check with the CDC at www.cdc.gov
- Check safety and security information

- Check banking information
- Sign up for Direct Deposit - www.onestop.uc.edu
- Check Health Insurance – waive UC's if needed at - www.onestop.uc.edu
- Copy all important documents and passport
- Register with the US State Department at

While Abroad:

- Register for Study Abroad Course each quarter you are abroad
- Keep in touch with your Ed Abroad Advisor

After Return to UC: (1-3 months after return)

- Check with UC International Programs to see if your transcript was received
- Meet with your Academic Advisor to determine course equivalencies and adjust credit hours
- Complete Outreach project, submit evaluation, grant report and outreach report (if you received a grant)
