

2007 Fine Arts Fund Campaign

The results are in for the university's 2007 Fine Arts Fund campaign. We would like to applaud you for meeting the university's goal! Once again the UC community supported the arts in the region in a big way with contributions and pledges totaling \$56,100 to date – highlights of the campaign include:

- 433 contributors gave to the Fine Arts Fund in 2007.
- 85% of contributors used the e-pledge option – this figure has doubled from last year.
- 31 area coordinators throughout UC's colleges and units solicited contributions from their colleagues, held raffles, and sent e-mail reminders.
- Three UC groups led the way with the most contributions to the Fine Arts Fund – College of Medicine, University Libraries, and VP for Health Affairs office.

It's great to see the increased participation that our University Fine Arts Fund campaign generated this year. We would like to thank all the members of the UC community who contributed. These donations will help to ensure the continued vitality of arts in our region. We attribute the success of this year's effort to a strong sense of community at UC and a keen recognition of the importance and value of the arts to our area.
