Your guide to safe living in the University of Cincinnati neighborhood.



Street Smart

Think Smart

Keep your car secure. Do not leave belongings in plain sight. Take the removable face plate off your stereo if you have one. Keep your residence secure. Lock your doors and windows when leaving, no matter how long you will be gone. Don't leave your key under the doormat or in "hiding places", and don't leave notes.
