

Undergraduate College of Business students from nearby counties in Kentucky are able to attend University of Cincinnati at a new metropolitan tuition rate. The student must be matriculated in a College of Business degree program. For new and continuing students, the metropolitan rate is the Ohio in-state tuition rate plus \$10.00 per credit hour each quarter to a maximum of a \$120.00 surcharge (12 to 18 hours per quarter).

For Autumn Quarter 2009 only, students living in several nearby counties in Indiana may be able to attend University of Cincinnati at the metropolitan tuition rate. The metropolitan rate is made available during Autumn Quarter 2009 for those students who do not immediately qualify for the Ohio in-state tuition rate established by the new Indiana Reciprocity Agreement. **Effective with requests for Winter Quarter 2010, the metropolitan rate for Indiana will be discontinued and all students may then only apply for Indiana Reciprocity.** If you believe that you are eligible for Indiana Reciprocity, apply for Indiana Reciprocity rather than for the metropolitan rate. **If** you are determined to be ineligible you should **then** apply for the metropolitan rate. Faxed copies **will not** be accepted. The Registrar's Office may require additional documentation prior to making a determination regarding your metro rate eligibility. Students who are approved for the College of Business (CoB) metropolitan rate who change majors from the CoB major to a major offered by another UC college **are subject** to the assessment of out-of state tuition rates.
