

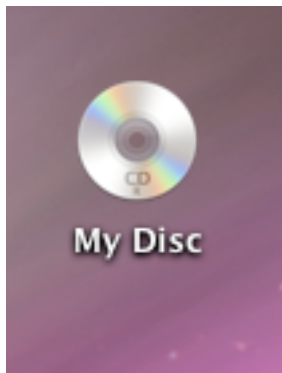
JMP 7.0.1 for Macintosh Installation Instructions

System Requirements

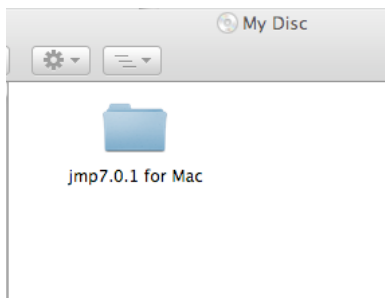
1. Any Macintosh computer running Mac OS X 10.4.8 or higher
2. 128 MB minimum RAM
3. 110 MB minimum free disk space
4. UNICODE compliant ODBC 3.0 or higher (required only if connecting to database)

Installation Instructions

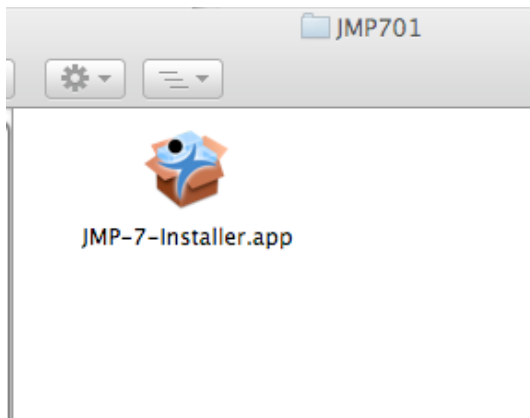
1. Insert CD. Double Click on the My Disc icon to open the JMP CD.



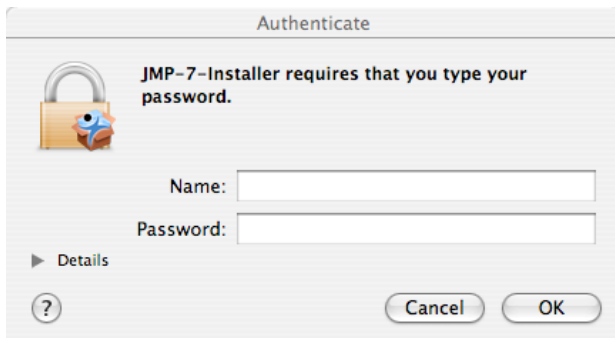
2. Double click JMP 7.0.1 for Mac folder.



3. Double click JMP-7-Installer.



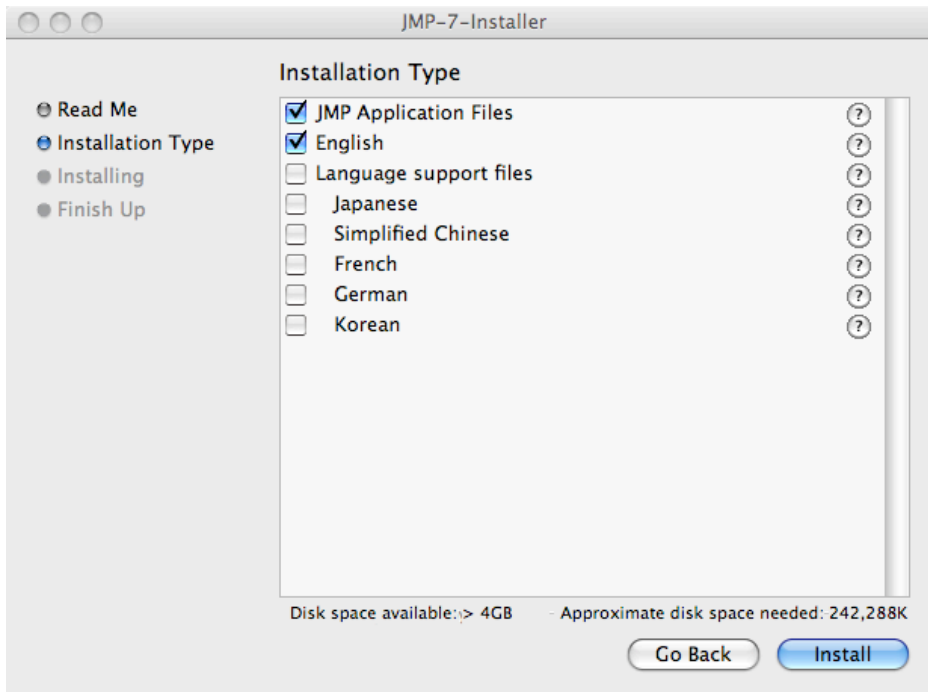
4. Enter your Administrator name and password.



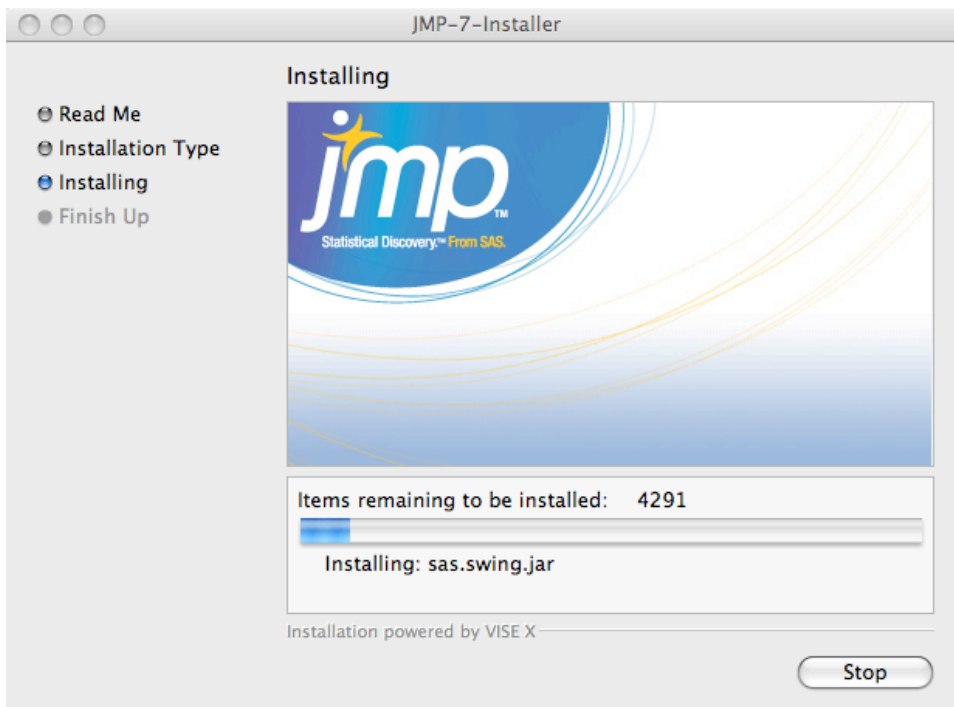
5. Read "Read Me" file and click Continue.



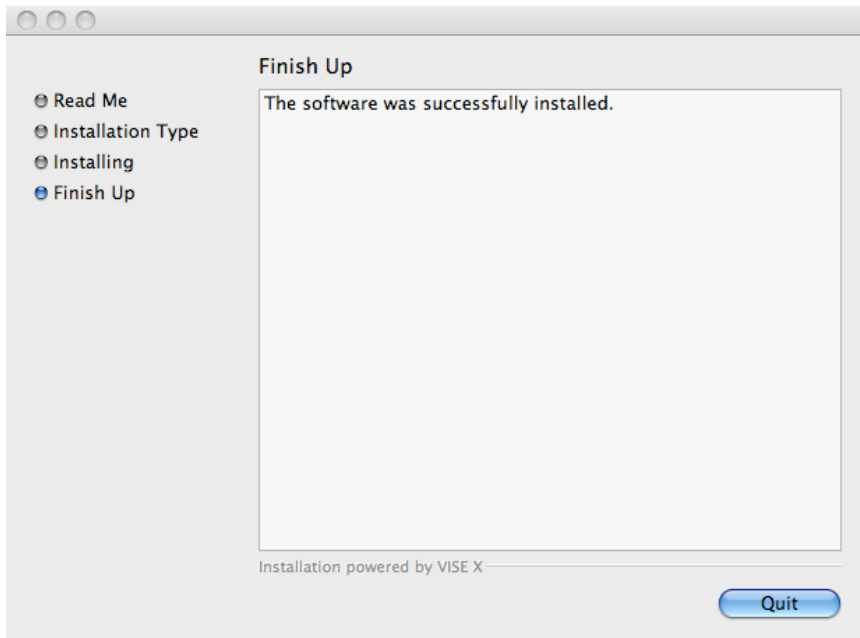
6. Click Install.



7. While installing, the progress bar will show you the remaining items to be installed.

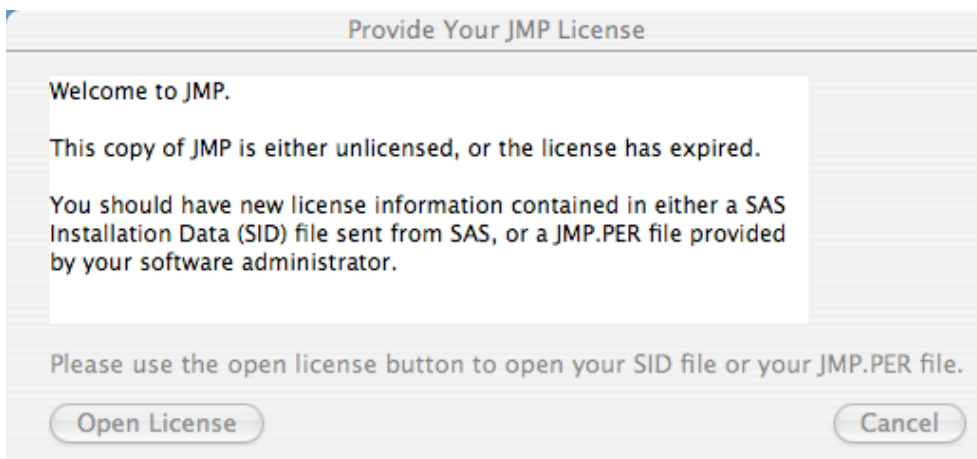


8. Click Quit.




9. You may now eject the CD.

Start JMP. (JMP is found in the Applications folder.) Click Open License



10. You should have received the license file in an email from software@uc.edu. Browse to location of the JMP license file, and then click Choose.

11. Enter your name and department,, or leave these fields blank. Click OK.



12. JMP will now start.

JMP 7.0.2 Upgrade Instructions

You may wish to upgrade your installation to JMP 7.0.2. The updater has been included on the JMP 7.0.1 CD.

1. Quit JMP 7.0.1 if it is running.
2. Insert the JMP 7.0.1 CD and click My Disk on the Desktop.
3. Click JMP702Updater to open the folder.
4. Click JMP-702-AL-Updater.dmg. This should create the JMP-702-AL-Updater volume icon on your Desktop.
5. Click The JMP-702-AL-Updater on your Desktop.
6. Click JMP 702 Annual License Updater to start the installation.
7. Click Open if prompted Are you sure you want to open it?
8. Enter your system administration username and password and click OK.
9. Read the Read Me file and click Continue.
10. Click Install.
11. While installation, the files installed will be listed.
12. Click Quit when finished.
