



Who can use the UHS?

Registered students of the University of Cincinnati may be seen at University Health Services (UHS).

What does the UHS cost?

Primary care is prepaid for students insured under the UC Student Health Insurance Program (SHI).

UHS has no providership agreements with any insurance company other than Student Health Insurance. Students covered by insurance other than SHI are responsible for any charges not covered by their specific health insurance plan.

Who has access to students' records?

Medical records are confidential and are not released to anyone—including parents and friends—without students' written consent. *For full details, view the HIPAA policy at www.uc.edu/uhs.*

Who staffs the UHS facilities?

The medical staff consists of full-time and part-time board certified physicians and consultants in various specialties. The UHS nurse practitioner, nurses, medical assistants, X-ray technicians, and pharmacists are all licensed professionals.

Do I need an appointment?

If students are unable to keep scheduled appointments for the Women's Health Clinic and/or Dermatology Clinic, students must call the UHS to cancel at least 24 hours prior to the appointment to avoid a no-show fee.

What UHS services are available?

Allergy Injections. Allergy desensitization schedules, prescribed by students' personal physicians, can be continued. Students must supply the antigenic extract and written instructions from their doctors. The serum is retained at the UHS. Students are required to wait 20 minutes after the injection as most shock-like reactions occur within this time and emergency equipment is readily available. There is an injection fee.

Pharmacy. Pharmacists are available at The Lindner Center to provide drugs prescribed by physicians and the specialists to whom students may be referred. The pharmacists—in addition to filling prescriptions—counsel students on the proper use of medications. In order to maintain low prices, payment is required at the time of dispensing. Currently, UHS pharmacy participates in the University of Cincinnati Student Health Insurance and a limited number of private insurance plans. Students should check with a UHS pharmacist to inquire if UHS is a participating member in their private insurance plan.

Women's Health Clinic. The Women's Health Clinic provides examination, treatment, counseling service, and follow-up in regard to routine gynecological care and contraception.

Dermatology Clinic. The clinic is available to students with SHI and only by referral from a UHS physician. The Dermatology Clinic provides examination, treatment, and follow-up for routine skin problems requiring dermatology services.

Clinical Laboratory. Some tests can be performed in the UHS Moderately Complex CLIA-approved laboratory. A reference laboratory is used for tests requiring highly technical procedures. Results are generally available within 24 to 48 hours.

X-ray Service. When ordered by a UHS physician, X-rays are promptly taken and viewed. After reviewing, the X-rays are forwarded to a staff radiologist at University Hospital, who then provides a final report to UHS.

Please Note: Primary care provided by UHS is no charge for students insured under the Student Health Insurance program. Mental health care services, prescription drugs, and dermatological specimens sent to an outside lab are subject to a copayment. Mental health care and dermatological specimens sent to an outside lab are also subject to the Pre-Existing Condition exclusion clause; dermatological specimens sent to an outside lab are also subject to the Deductible.

Sports Medicine. The UHS provides primary team physician care and coordinates a sports medicine program for all Bearcat teams. Care for sports-related and orthopedic problems is also available for all students.

Vision Services. This service is available at The Lindner Center for students' convenience but is not covered by UC Student Health Insurance. Please call the UHS office at (513) 556-2564 for further information or to set up an appointment.

Physical Therapy. Physical therapy is available at The Lindner Center to those students who obtain referrals from the UHS.

Mental Health Clinic. Evaluation and psychotherapy are available by appointment. To receive psychiatric care, students must be referred. *This service is only for students insured under Student Health Insurance.*

Policy on Medical History Reports & Immunizations

The University requires certain student groups (e.g., international and health professions) to submit medical history and immunization records; and to obtain TB-skin testing upon matriculation. Some academic programs or departments (e.g., athletes, health professions) also have additional medical requirements, which may be available at the UHS.

International students must register at the UHS and may be required to have TB testing and/or a chest x-ray.
