- Outbound P.M. Trips Only

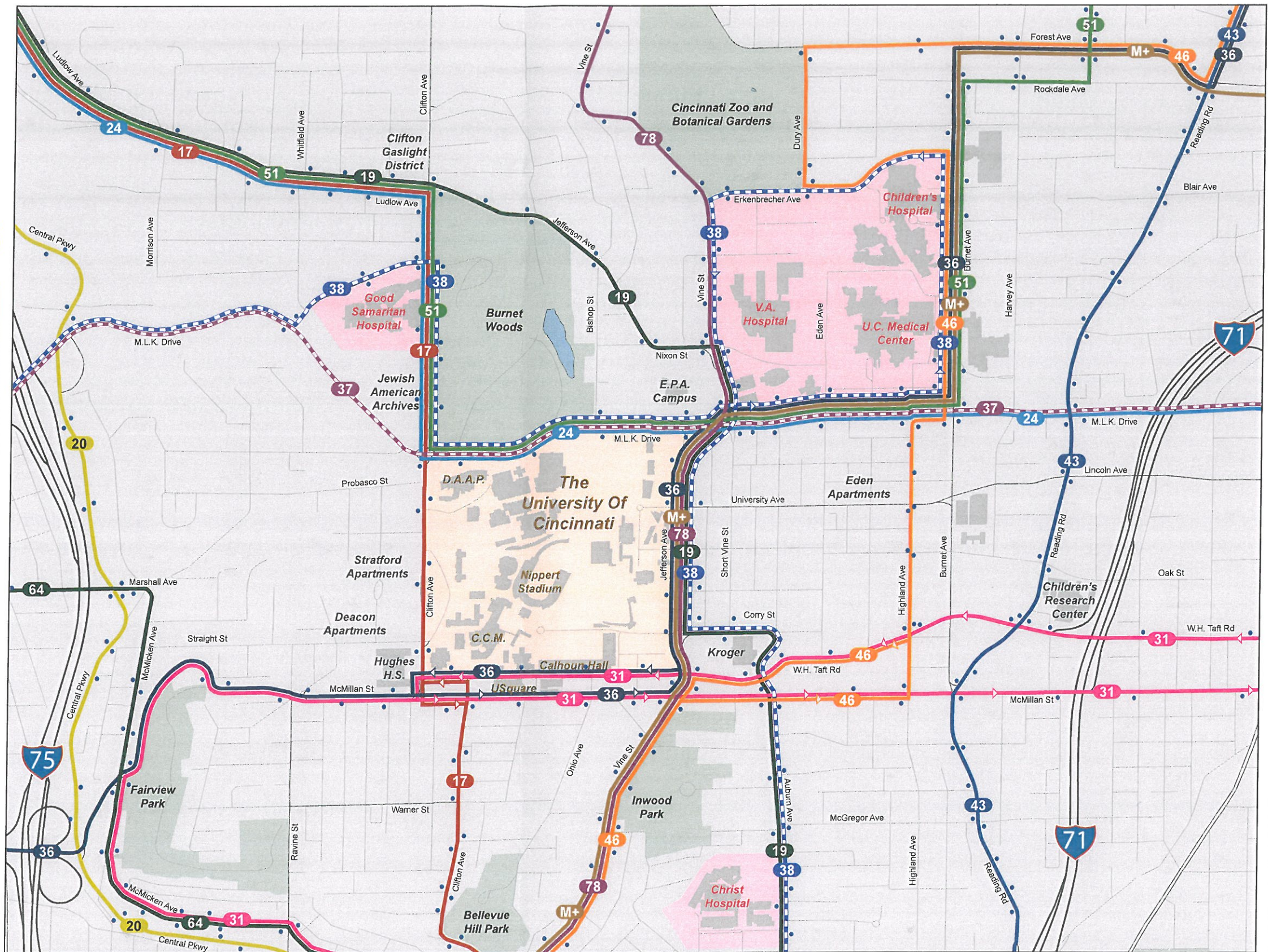
Reduced Fares

- ACCESS Card** - Shared-Ride service pass for riders with disabilities (ADA-eligible only)
- Fare Deal Card** - Half-price fare card for riders who are 65 or older, have a Medicare Card, are disabled, and/or have an ACCESS Card
- Cincinnati State Discount Card** - Discounted fare pass for students and faculty of Cincinnati State College
- UC / EZ Ride Card** - Discounted fare card options for students and faculty of the University of Cincinnati
- CPS Student Smart Card** - Pass options for students in Cincinnati Public Schools
- Children Under 35** - Free Fares
- Children Between 35 and 45** - Half Fares

Free Transfers

For all purchases with the Transit App or the Hamilton County EZfare Pass, good for 120 minutes or 2 bus trips, whichever comes first.

How To Ride

- 1. Plan**
 - Download the Transit App to plan your trip and pay your fare on your smartphone with EZfare. Track your bus and see real time arrivals with the Transit App.
 - Subscribe to free Cincy EZAlerts via text message or email for the routes you ride.
 - Check out all of Metro's maps and schedules. You can also search by popular destinations and communities served.
 - Use Google Transit trip planner for detailed trip information from your doorstep to your destination!
- 2. Pay**
 - Head to your nearest bus stop or one of Metro's 21 park and ride locations to start your trip.
 - As the bus approaches, signal to the operator that you want to ride by waving your hand.
 - As your bus pulls up to the stop, stay a safe distance from the curb and make sure you have your fare in hand.
 - As you board the bus, show your in-app fare payment to the driver, swipe or drop your fare in the farebox, or swipe your pass.
- 3. Ride**
 - Track your bus in real time using the Transit App.
 - As your bus nears your stop, firmly pull the cord located above you along the sides of the bus to indicate to the driver that you wish to depart.
 - Wait for the bus to reach a full stop and exit the bus from either the front or rear door.
