



# What to Bring to Campus

## Undergraduate Students

### Stationery Supplies

- Desk Lamp
- Laptop, computer, printer/ink and surge protector
- Desk Organizers

### Bedroom Essentials

- Bedding- comforter, pillow, pillowcases, bed sheets, hypoallergenic mattress cover, mattress topper (refer to your residence community's bed type/size)
- Fan
- Carpet or rug
- Posters/pictures, damage free adhesive hooks (no nails)
- Storage containers
- Alarm clock

### Bathroom Essentials

- Bath linens
- Shower caddy and shoes (Dabney, Daniels, Calhoun, Siddall)

- Trash can and bags
- Toilet paper, hand soap and bathroom cleaning supplies if you have a private or connecting bathroom (gloves, shower/toilet cleaners, plunger, toilet brush)
- Bathroom rugs (for rooms with private baths)
- Bathrobe

### Kitchen Essentials

- Cooking supplies and food storage containers
- Kitchen supplies (can opener, dish soap, sponge, etc.)
- Paper towels
- Dish rack drainer
- Microwave-safe dishes and mugs
- Small coffee pot or individual cup coffee maker

- Hand sanitizer
- Facial coverings
