

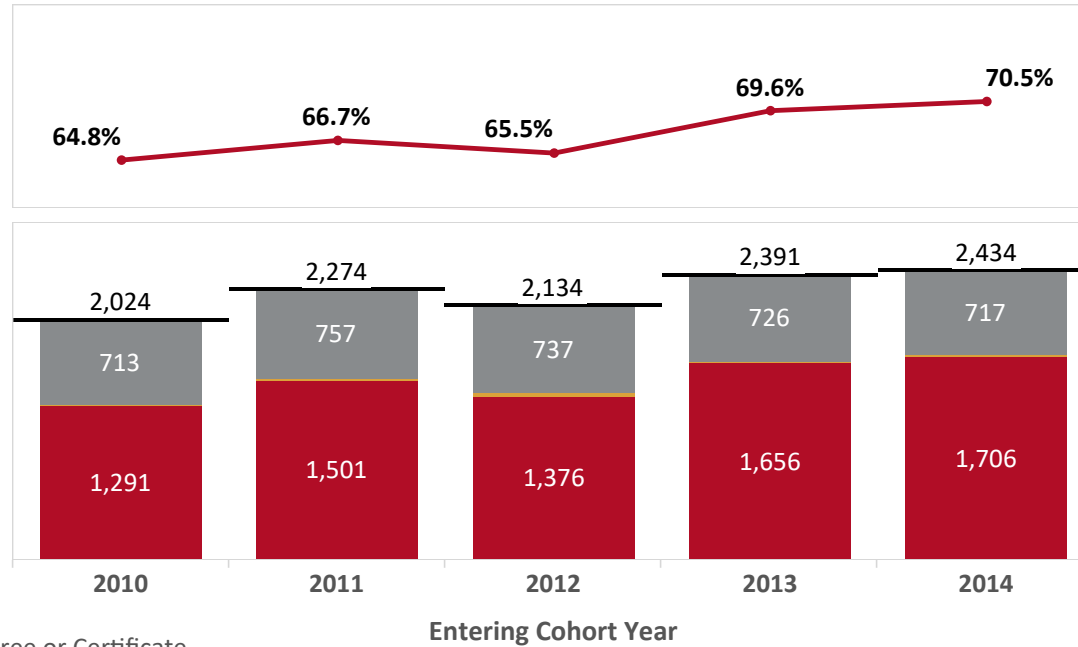






## Overall Graduation Rates

**Notes:**  
 - IPEDS graduation time is 150% of the time it takes to complete a degree. For associate degrees and certificates that is three years, for baccalaureate degrees that is six years.  
 - IPEDS counts baccalaureate degree-seeking students as graduates if they complete a bachelor's degree in six years, an associate degree or certificate in three years, or go on to enroll in a PharmD program without completing an undergraduate degree.  
 - The 2009-2012 graduation rates have been revised to reflect official figures as reported to USD..
