A. Academic and Student Affairs Committee

- 1. The Board of Trustees approved the reappointment of James J. Augsburger, M.D. as Director (Chair) of the Department of Ophthalmology in the College of Medicine effective September 1, 2006 through August 31, 2014.
- 2. The Board of Trustees approved the reappointment of Jeffrey L. Susman, M.D. as Director (Chair) of the Department of Family Medicine in the College of Medicine effective September 1, 2006 through August 31, 2014.
- 3. 9. The Board of Trustees approved the full proposal from the College of Medicine and the College of Education, Criminal Justice and Human Services for a Master of Public Health degree in Public Health Sciences.

B. Finance and Administration Committee

- 1. The Board of Trustees approved a continuation of the currently approved FY 2007 budget to go into effect on July 1, 2007 until such time that the State of Ohio budget bill is signed into law. At that time, a revised FY 2008 University Budget will be prepared and submitted to the Board of Trustees at the Special Board meeting scheduled for July 17, 2007.
- 2. The Board of Trustees approved renaming the Institute for Lifetime Education to the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at the University of Cincinnati.

- 3. The Board of Trustees approved the rescission of University Rule 70-3-11 Bookstore discount policy. Based on the Operating Agreement with Follett Higher Education Group, Inc. dated September 6, 2005, the university rule was no longer needed.*
- 4. The Board of Trustees approved the agreement between the University of Cincinnati and the Combined Insurance Company of America (CICA), in connection with the 2006-2007 student health insurance policy.
- 5. The Board of Trustees approved the title change of the Associate Senior Vice President and University Dean of the Graduate School to Vice Provost and University Dean of the Graduate School. The board also approved the amendment to various university rules to reflect this title change.*
- 6. The Board of Trustees approved the formation of and membership in the "Living Well" Consortium.
- 7. The Board of Trustees approved the Taft Memorial Fund budgetary recommendations for the 2007-2008 fiscal year.
- 8. The Board of Trustees approved the annual resolution designating officers to serve as representatives of the University in outside public organizations for insurance and indemnification purposes.

C. Governance and Audit Committee

- 1. The Board of Trustees approved the changes to three University rules governing the reporting of collateral employment and conflicts of interest. These changes are intended to enlarge the University's oversight over relationships, and to assist in the implementation of a uniform campus-wide electronic reporting system, which will ease the reporting process for faculty and staff.*
- 2. The Board of Trustees approved the University of Cincinnati Academic Health Center Compliance Program Annual Report for 2006.
