

# TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**Degree/Program:** Bachelor of Arts (BA) / Political Science

**Introduction:** This agreement details the applicability of courses from the Cincinnati State Technical & Community College AA/AARTS to the BA Political Science program in the UC College of Arts & Sciences. Students who complete the AA/AARTS at Cincinnati State Technical & Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

**Articulation Overview:** Graduates from Cincinnati State Technical & Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Arts & Sciences will enter into the third year of the of BA Political Science program. It is strongly recommended that Cincinnati State students utilize the Greater Cincinnati Collegiate Connection (GC3) to cross register and complete Political Science major courses as a visiting UC student, if equivalent courses are not offered at Cincinnati State.

**Admission Criteria:** \*Note: completing the courses on the appendices below does not guarantee admission to the UC BA Political Science program.

**Minimum GPA:** 2.0

**BA Completion:** Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

**Admission Period:** Cincinnati State Technical & Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Arts & Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between May 2023 and July 2026).

**Agreement Execution Date:** May 2023

**Agreement End Date:** July 2026

## EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Cincinnati State Technical & Community College and the UC College of Arts & Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

**Cincinnati State Technical & Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic adviser to monitor possible changes.**
