Introduction: This agreement details the *applicability* of courses from the Cincinnati State Technical and Community College Associate of Arts (Social Work Concentration) to the Bachelor of Social Work Online in the College of Allied Health Sciences. Students who complete the Associate of Arts (Social Work Concentration) at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College have satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Cincinnati State Technical and Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the College of Allied Health Sciences will enter the third year of the Bachelor of Social Work Online degree.

Admission Criteria:

*Note: completing the courses on the addendums below does not guarantee admission to the UC Bachelor of Social Work Online program.

Minimum GPA: 2.75

BSW Completion (online): The online program is a year-round, part-time program that is designed to be completed within 2 years (6 semesters, including summers). If students skip courses or fail a course, the timeline for completion will not be met. This makes it imperative that students work closely with their UC academic advisor to adhere to the prescribed plan of study.

Admission Period: Cincinnati State Technical and Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between August 2020 and August 2023).

Agreement Execution Date: August 2020

Agreement End Date: August 2023

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Cincinnati State Technical and Community College and the UC College of Allied Health Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

Cincinnati State Technical and Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
