Target Institution: University of Cincinnati / College of Arts and Sciences Degree/Program: Bachelor of Arts in Communication	
Introduction: This agreement details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the Cincinnati State Technical and Community College Associate of Arts degree to the Bachelor of Arts in Communication degree at the UC College of Arts and Sciences. As a public institution governed by the Ohio Department of Higher Education, UC complies with the Ohio Transfer Module and the Transfer Assurance Guides (TAGs). Students who complete the Associate of Arts or Science at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College have satisfied the UC General Education requirement, with the exception of foreign language.	
Articulation Overview: Graduates from Cincinnati State Technical and Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Arts and Sciences will enter the third year of the Bachelor of Arts in Communication degree program. Cincinnati State Technical and Community College students may complete the degree online; it is essential to maintain consistent communication with an advisor for class offerings.	
Admission Criteria: Please note: completing the courses on the worksheet below does not guarantee admission to the UC Bachelor of Arts in Communication degree program. If a student plans to complete the degree 100% online, they must have sixty-one (61) applicable credit hours before matriculation. Students without 61 applicable hours should speak with an admissions representative or an adviser about options. Minimum GPA: 2.00 Admission Period: Cincinnati State Technical and Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Arts and Sciences during the duration of this agreement, i.e. between December 2019 and December 2022.

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Cincinnati State Technical and Community College and the UC College of Arts and Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

Cincinnati State Technical and Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
