

# TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Clark State College, Associate of Applied Science, Social Services Technology  
to  
University of Cincinnati, College of Allied Health Sciences, Bachelor of Social Work, Social Work (Online)



**Originating Institution:** Clark State College

**Degree/Program:** Associate of Applied Science (AAS) / Social Services Technology

**Target Institution:** University of Cincinnati / College of Allied Health Sciences

**Degree/Program:** Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) / Social Work (Online)

**Introduction:** This agreement details the applicability of courses from the Clark State College AAS Social Services Technology to the BSW Social Work (Online) in the UC College of Allied Health Sciences. Students who complete the AAS Social Services Technology at Clark State College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

**Articulation Overview:** Graduates from Clark State College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Allied Health Sciences will enter in the third year of the program in the UC BSW Social Work (Online) degree.

**Admission Criteria:** \*Note: completing the courses on the addendum below does not guarantee admission to the UC BSW Social Work (Online) program.

**Minimum Transfer Credits:** 60

**Minimum GPA:** 2.75

**BSW Completion (Online):** The online program is a year-round, part-time program that is designed to be completed within 2 years (6 semesters, including summers). If students skip courses or fail a course, the timeline for completion will not be met. This makes it imperative that students work closely with their UC academic advisor to adhere to the prescribed plan of study.

**Admission Period:** Clark State College students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between November 2023 and July 2026).

**Agreement Execution Date:** November 2023

**Agreement End Date:** July 2026

## EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for the duration of the agreement. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Clark State College and the UC College of Allied Health Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

**Clark State College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.**
