- *Minimum GPA*: 2.8 cumulative (all prior institutions)
- Admission Criteria: Students who plan to transfer upon completion of this agreement should apply for admission by April 1st for a fall semester start term. This allows students to connect with a CECH advisor to discuss the professional coursework series and student teaching requirements in the final semesters at UC
- **BSED Completion**. Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.
