**Degree/Program:** Bachelor of Technical & Applied Studies (BTAS) / Applied Administration - Healthcare Leadership (Online)

**Introduction:** This agreement details the applicability of AAS allied health or health-related designated programs from Lorain County Community College to the BTAS Applied Administration - Healthcare Leadership (Online) at University of Cincinnati Online. Students who complete an AAS allied health or health-related designated programs at Lorain County Community College will enter the BTAS Applied Administration - Healthcare Leadership (Online) program at junior status.

**Articulation Overview:** Graduates from Lorain County Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the University of Cincinnati Online will enter with a maximum of 60 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the Bachelor of Technical & Applied Studies-Healthcare Leadership (Online) degree.

**Admission Criteria:** Students entering the BTAS Applied Administration - Healthcare Leadership (Online) program must meet the following criteria:

- Earn an AAS from Lorain County Community College in an allied health or health-related program noted above
- Hold a certification/licensure in their area of practice
- Complete a UC Admission Application for the BTAS Applied Administration - Healthcare Leadership (Online) program (including providing official transcripts from prior attended institutions)
- Pay UC Matriculation fee

**Minimum GPA:** 2.00

**BTAS Completion:** The BTAS Applied Administration - Healthcare Leadership (Online) is a bachelor's degree completion program. Designed for students who have earned an associate degree in an allied health or health-related program, to be completed in 5 continuous semesters as outlined in the attached Transfer Degree Map appendix. UC General Education requirements must be satisfied for graduation. If UC General Education requirements are not completed within the associate degree program, any missing requirements will be completed within the remaining 60 hours of the BTAS Applied Administration - Healthcare Leadership (Online) program. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

**Admission Period:** Lorain County Community College students must be admitted to the University of Cincinnati Online during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between March 2023 and July 2026).

**Agreement Execution Date:** March 2023

**Agreement End Date:** July 2026

**EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:** This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Lorain County Community College and the University of Cincinnati Online agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

**Lorain County Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.**
