Introduction: This agreement details the applicability of courses from the Owens Community College AAS Early Childhood Education Technology to the BS Early Childhood Education (Birth-5) ONLINE in the College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services. Students who complete the AAS Early Childhood Education Technology at Owens Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Owens Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services will enter with 63 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the BS Early Childhood Education (Birth-5) ONLINE degree.

Admission Criteria:

*Note: completing the courses on the addendums below does not guarantee admission to the BS Early Childhood Education (Birth-5) ONLINE program.

Minimum GPA: 2.50

BS Completion: Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

Admission Period: Owens Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between July 2021 and July 2024).

Agreement Execution Date: July 2021

Agreement End Date: July 2024

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Owens Community College and the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

As strong partners, Owens Community College Early Childhood Education Technology program agrees to provide direct access to students in the last semester of their degree program to a University of Cincinnati representative. This could be in the form of a classroom visit or other opportunities to directly interact and educate students about the program at the University of Cincinnati. Owens Community College Early Childhood Education Technology program also agrees to provide a graduation list with email addresses. The University of Cincinnati College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services will provide success rates of incoming cohorts of Owens Community College Early Childhood Education Technology students upon request.

Owens Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
