Originating Institution: Sinclair Community College
Degree/Program: Associate of Arts (AA) / Social Work

Target Institution: University of Cincinnati / College of Allied Health Sciences
Degree/Program: Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) / Social Work (Online)

Introduction: This agreement details the applicability of courses from the Sinclair Community College AA Social Work to the BSW Social Work (Online) in the UC College of Allied Health Sciences. Students who complete the AA Social Work at Sinclair Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Sinclair Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Allied Health Sciences will enter in the third year of the program in the UC BSW Social Work (Online) degree.

Admission Criteria: *Note: completing the courses on the addendum below does not guarantee admission to the UC BSW Social Work (Online) program.

Minimum Transfer Credits: 60

Minimum GPA: 2.75 – Competitive applicants (2.5 or above) who do not meet the minimum GPA may be offered conditional admission contingent upon successfully completing General Education courses and raising the GPA to the 2.75 minimum requirement.

BSW Completion (Online): The online program is a year-round, part-time program that is designed to be completed within 2 years (6 semesters, including summers). If students skip courses or fail a course, the timeline for completion will not be met. This makes it imperative that students work closely with their UC academic advisor to adhere to the prescribed plan of study.

Admission Period: Sinclair Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between March 2023 to July 2026).

Agreement Execution Date: March 2023

Agreement End Date: July 2026

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Sinclair Community College and the UC College of Allied Health Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. Both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

Sinclair Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
