

# TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**Originating Institution:** San Juan College

**Degree/Program:** Associate of Applied Science (AAS) / Occupational Therapy Assistant

**Target Institution:** University of Cincinnati / College of Allied Health Sciences

**Degree/Program:** Bachelor of Science (BS) / Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online)

**Introduction:** This agreement details the applicability of courses from the San Juan College Associate of Applied Science in Occupational Therapy Assistant program to the BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online) in the University of Cincinnati (UC) College of Allied Health Sciences. Students who complete the Associate of Applied Science in Occupational Therapy Assistant at San Juan College have satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

A maximum of 90 semester hours transferred from San Juan College (70-74 credit hours from OTA program and any applicable excess credit) will apply toward the 120 semester hours required for the BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online). Depending on the number of semester hours transferred, students may be required to take additional coursework at UC to meet the total of 120 semester hours for graduation.

**Articulation Overview:** Graduates from San Juan College who have followed the prescribed program, completed the AAS, and are accepted into the College of Allied Health Sciences will enter at junior standing in the BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online) program. All degree requirements are completed online.

**Admission Criteria:** \*Note: completing the courses on the transfer degree map below does not guarantee admission to the UC BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online) program.

A student must:

- Hold an AAS degree from the Occupational Therapy Assistant program at San Juan College.
- Hold credentials as an occupational therapy assistant as certified by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy; conditional acceptance is granted into the program for those who are eligible to take the OTA exam and have a plan in place to complete the exam.
- Complete a UC application, including submission of official transcripts from all institutions.  
\*Note: UC application fee for the BS: Health Sciences Pre-Occupational Therapy program will be waived for San Juan College students who have completed the AAS OTA program, for any admission term, through the calendar date marking the end of the Fall 2023 semester at UC. This waiver will be renegotiated after this period.
- Pay UC's matriculation fee.

**Minimum GPA:** 2.5

**Admission Period:** San Juan College students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e., between July 2022 and July 2025).

**Agreement Execution Date:** July 2022

**Agreement End Date:** July 2025

**EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:**

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. San Juan College and the UC College of Allied Health Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

**San Juan College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.**
