Introduction: This agreement details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the Sinclair Community College AS Business Management to BBA Designated Programs in the Lindner College of Business. Students who complete the AS Business Administration at Sinclair Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Sinclair Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the Lindner College of Business will enter with 57 hours of transfer credit applicable toward a BBA Designated Program degree.

Admission Criteria: *Note: completing the courses on the appendices below does not guarantee admission to the UC Designated BBA program.

Minimum GPA: 2.5 in all college level work

Math Proficiency: Passing grade ("D – "or better) earned in MAT 2160 Calculus for Business & Economics is required.

BBA Completion: Depending on the BBA major a student chooses, completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

Admission Period: Sinclair Community College students must be admitted to the UC Lindner College of Business during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between October 2022 and July 31, 2025).

Agreement Execution Date: October 2022
Agreement End Date: July 31, 2025

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Sinclair Community College and the UC Lindner College of Business agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. Both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

Sinclair Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
