Target Institution: University of Cincinnati / College of Allied Health Sciences Degree/Program: Bachelor of Social Work	
Introduction: This agreement details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the Sinclair Community College Associate of Arts Social Work to the Bachelor of Social Work in the College of Allied Health Sciences. Students who complete the Associate of Arts Social Work at Sinclair Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.	
Articulation Overview: Graduates from Sinclair Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Allied Health Sciences will enter with 60 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the Bachelor of Social Work degree.	
Admission Criteria: *Note: completing the courses on the addendums below does not guarantee admission to the UC Bachelor of Social Work program. Minimum GPA: 2.75 BSW Completion (face-to-face): The face-to-face program is a full-time program (two semesters per year). Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation. Admission Period: Sinclair Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between March 2020 and March 2023).

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Sinclair Community College and the UC College of Allied Health Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

Sinclair Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.

Intro to Social Welfare/Social Work TOOC: May be taken in an open access/self-paced format for credit and to meet the prerequisites of SW 1050 & SW 1051 prior to entry into the program. Both courses count as SW 3030 – Introduction to Social Welfare Institutions and the Social Work Profession. *If this option is taken*, students may take an additional elective in place of SW 1051.

SCC 1101: If a student takes SCC 1101 at Sinclair, UC will waive the course requirement of HLTH 1002; but students will still need to complete 1 credit of Social Work Elective at UC (consult advisor – as listed in UC remaining coursework section).

Foreign Language/Cultural Competency: Fulfilled by completing the final course in either a one-year (10 credit) basic foreign language sequence, or a two-year (12 credit) extended basic foreign language sequence. Any foreign language sequence including the two-year (12 credit) ASL sequence may be used to satisfy this requirement. OR Complete 12 hours of coursework where the primary function is developing cultural competency with a specific population. *If a student chooses as sequence of 3 credit hour courses to complete their cultural competence requirement (9 credits), the last credit may be waived.*
