

# TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**Originating Institution:** Sinclair Community College  
**Degree/Program:** Associates of Applied Science (AAS) / Applied Psychology

**Target Institution:** University of Cincinnati / College of Arts & Sciences  
**Degree/Program:** Bachelor of Science (BS) / Psychology

**Introduction:** This agreement details the applicability of courses from the Sinclair Community College AAS Applied Psychology to the BS Psychology in the UC College of Arts & Sciences. Students who complete the AAS Applied Psychology at Sinclair Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

**Articulation Overview:** Graduates from Sinclair Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Arts & Sciences will enter with 62 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the BS Psychology degree.

**Admission Criteria:** \*Note: completing the courses on the appendices below does not guarantee admission to the UC BA Psychology program.

**Minimum GPA:** 2.00

**BS Completion:** Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

**Admission Period:** Sinclair Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Arts & Sciences during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between January 2021 and January 2024).

**Agreement Execution Date:** January 2021

**Agreement End Date:** January 2024

## **EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:**

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Sinclair Community College and the UC College of Arts & Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

**Sinclair Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.**
