- Students who complete the AAS Human and Social Services – Gerontology at Stark State College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.
- Students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement.
- Minimum Transfer Credits: 60
- Minimum GPA: 2.75 – Competitive applicants (2.5 or above) who do not meet the minimum GPA may be offered conditional admission contingent upon successfully completing General Education courses and raising the GPA to the 2.75 minimum requirement.
