Admission Criteria:

- Completion of the courses on this worksheet does not guarantee admission to the UC program.
- Students who complete the AS Occupational Therapy Assistant at Kapi'olani Community College have satisfied the UC General Education requirement.
- A student must:
 - Hold an AS degree from the Occupational Therapy Assistant at Kapi'olani Community College
 - Hold credentials as an occupational therapy assistant as certified by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy; conditional acceptance is granted into the program for those who are eligible to take the OTA exam and have an plan in place to complete the exam.
 - Complete a UC application (including submission of official transcripts from all institutions attended and payment of application fee).
 - Pay UC's matriculation fee.
- Students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement.
- Minimum GPA: 2.50

You should consult with an academic advisor/student success coordinator each semester to ensure you maintain appropriate degree progress and are fulfilling all requirements based on the credit you transfer in to UC. **Course sequencing below assumes a fall start date.** If starting the program during any other term, please consult with your academic advisor. Students are eligible to transfer the 76 semester hours required of the OTA program and up to 14 additional semester hours of coursework as indicated by italics in the remaining coursework section. Students earning less than these semester hours will be required to take additional coursework at UC to meet the total of 120 semester hours for graduation; please see the *recommended additional coursework* section below. For details beyond course planning, please consult with your academic advisor or the Transfer & Transition Advising Center.
