Admission Criteria:

- Students who complete the AAS in Occupational Therapy Assistant at Trident Technical College have satisfied the UC General Education requirement.
- In addition to completing the courses on the Transfer Degree Map students must also meet the following conditions to be eligible for admission to the UC BS Health Sciences: Pre-Occupational Therapy (Online) program:
 - Hold an AAS degree from the Occupational Therapy Assistant program at Trident Technical College.
 - Hold credentials as an occupational therapy assistant as certified by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy; conditional acceptance is granted into the program for those who are eligible to take the OTA exam and have a plan in place to complete the exam.
 - Complete a UC application (including submission of official transcripts from all institutions attended and payment of application fee).
 - Pay UC's matriculation fee.
- Students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement.
- Minimum GPA: 2.50
