Introduction: This agreement details the <u>applicability</u>* of courses from the University of Cincinnati Blue Ash College to the baccalaureate degree program in mortuary science at the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science.

The <u>acceptability</u>** of credit to the University is determined by the central credit evaluation process. The purpose of this agreement and its appendices is to describe which of those acceptable credits apply to requirements in this particular college and major at CCMS.

- *Applicable transfer courses satisfy degree requirements for graduation. The purpose of this Transfer Articulation Agreement is to identify transfer courses that will apply toward degree requirements.
- **Acceptable transfer courses meet all UC requirements and credit is granted. Acceptable credit that does <u>not</u> satisfy a student's degree requirements is accepted as free elective credit.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from the University of Cincinnati Blue Ash College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science will enter the third year of the baccalaureate Mortuary Science Program.

Admission Criteria: Please note: completing the courses on the attached worksheet does not guarantee admission to the CCMS Mortuary Science program.

Minimum GPA: 2.5 cumulative

Admission Period: UC Blue Ash College students must be admitted to the CCMS during the duration of this agreement, i.e. between March 1, 2020 and February 28, 2025.

Agreement Execution Date: March 1, 2020 | Agreement End Date: February 28, 2025

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for five years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. UCBA and the CCMS agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum. UCBA students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
