



Articulation Agreement Between University of Cincinnati – Lindner College of Business And Chatfield College

PURPOSE

This articulation agreement is designed to coordinate transfer policies, enhance advising, and promote the acceptance of the transfer of associate degrees from the Chatfield College (CC) to University of Cincinnati-Lindner College of Business (UC-LCB).

II. ELEMENTS OF THE AGREEMENT

A. Admissions Practices

1. UC-LCB will accept applications from students who wish to transfer from CC into the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) program at the UC-LCB. Transferring Chatfield applicants must meet the same admissions criteria as other students applying for transfer to UC-LCB.
2. CC students who graduate with an associate's degree, are applying to the related degree program as UC-LCB, have a CC cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 and a C- or better in MAT212, are guaranteed admissions to the UC-LCB. If an associate degree is not earned, the CC student will need a 2.5 cumulative GPA for all college level work attempted. Once admitted, CC transfer students shall be subject to all other policies and procedures, including residency requirement of UC-LCB, as outlined in the UC-LCB catalog.
3. Students who have questions may consult with a counselor and/or advisor at either institution for assistance. (UC will provide assistance through the Admissions Transfer Center). Students transferring to UC-LCB prior to graduating from CC will need a minimum of 30 credit hours successfully completed at CC to avoid ACT or SAT testing score requirements.

B. Acceptance and Application of Credits

1. Completion of the Associate of Arts degree at CC and an additional two credit hours of nature science will fulfill UC-LCB general education requirements.
2. The maximum number of transfer credits accepted from CC will be equal to 64 semester credit hours. Under this agreement, all courses will be transferred into the bachelor of



business administration program in their entirety allowing the transfer student to complete their bachelor of business administration at UC-LCB in approximately two years of full-time study.

3. All collegiate level courses completed at Chatfield College with a "C" or better grade, by students who choose to transfer before completing an associate degree, will be accepted toward the student's class standing at University of Cincinnati-Lindner College of Business University. It should be noted that the student may be required to retake any course in which s/he received a grade of "C" where there is a higher minimum grade required for all native University of Cincinnati-Lindner College of Business University students pursuing the same academic program. These credits will also be considered for application to the student's degree requirements using the same criteria used for native University of Cincinnati-Lindner College of Business University students.
4. If a student does not have the prerequisite for a 3000 or 4000 level course at UC-LCB, if one is required they will be required to take the prerequisite course before taking upper division course.
5. UC-LCB will evaluate courses/credits earned through Advanced Placement (AP), College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), or other testing programs. UC-LCB also will evaluate courses/credits earned at other institutions. Students seeking credit for these courses must provide the university with official transcripts for evaluation.

C. Implementation of the Agreement

1. The UC-LCB and Chatfield College agree to review this agreement annually. Chatfield and UC-LCB will each designate an individual to serve as liaison for the purposes of monitoring this agreement. Each institution will provide updated catalogs to the other immediately upon their availability. Upon request, UC-LCB agrees to provide CC reports on enrolled CC transfer students, their majors and academic performance to the extent permitted by law.
2. UC-LCB and CC agree to assist each other in promoting this agreement appropriately in their respective promotional materials, events, websites and reports.
3. The University of Cincinnati-Lindner College of Business University will appropriately include this agreement in any listing of articulation and transfer agreements and will communicate this information through a web portal designed to disseminate transfer information to students, staff, and faculty. Other methods of communication, when



appropriate, might include and are not limited to inclusion in the college catalog, program specific materials, and graduate mailings.

4. All notices to be given shall be delivered in writing as follows:


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- 5. The curriculum in effect at the time a student first enrolls at CC will be honored by UC-LCB if the student completes an associate's degree and successfully transfers to UC-LCB within 4 years of that first enrollment at CC.
- 6. This agreement may be amended with addendums, as necessary, for specific program articulation without affecting the master agreement.
- 7. This agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either party at the end of six months prior written notice. In the event that this agreement is terminated, the terms of the agreement contained herein will remain in effect for the maximum transitional period of one (1) year to accommodate students already enrolled under the agreement.
