<b>Target Institution:</b> University of Cincinnati / College of Allied Health Sciences <b>Degree/Program:</b> Bachelor of Science in Health Information Management – Distance Learning	
<b>Introduction:</b> This agreement details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the Chippewa Valley Technical College Associate of Applied Science in Health Information Management & Technology degree to the Bachelor of Science in Health Information Management degree in the UC College of Allied Health Sciences. Students who complete the Associate of Applied Science Health Information Management & Technology degree at Chippewa Valley Technical College have satisfied the UC General Education requirements.	
<b>Articulation Overview:</b> Graduates from Chippewa Valley Technical College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Allied Health Sciences will be granted junior status in the Bachelor of Science in Health Information Management program. All degree requirements are completed online.	
<b>Admission Criteria:</b> Applications are accepted continuously throughout the year. A complete application requires the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Completed online University of Cincinnati application</li><li>• Completed BS HIM program application</li><li>• Official transcripts of all colleges/universities attended</li><li>• Associate of Science or Associate of Applied Science degree in Health Information Management from a CAHIIM-accredited program<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Degree must include sufficient general education courses (i.e. English) and a minimum of 68 semester credit hours</li><li>○ The 6-credit difference between the two programs can be addressed with any general education of elective courses taken at Chippewa Valley Technical College, during the interim between the two programs or during the first year at the University of Cincinnati</li></ul></li><li>• Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT); recent graduates of an associate degree program have six (6) months to successfully complete the RHIT examination</li><li>• Submit current AHIMA membership card or proof of maintenance of RHIT certification</li><li>• Resume of professional and educational background</li></ul>	
<b>Minimum GPA:</b> 2.6/4.0	
<b>Admission Period:</b> Chippewa Valley Technical College students must be admitted to the UC College Allied Health Sciences of during the duration of this agreement, i.e. between June 2018 and June 2023.	
<b>Agreement Execution Date:</b> June 2018	<b>Agreement End Date:</b> June 2023

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

**EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:**



This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.


