Introduction: This agreement details the applicability of courses from the Cuyahoga Community College AAS Human Services: Alcohol/Chemical Dependency Option to the UC BS Substance Abuse Counseling ONLINE in the College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services. Students who complete the AAS Human & Social Services: Chemical Dependency at Cuyahoga Community College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Cuyahoga Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services will enter with 60 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the BS Substance Abuse Counseling degree.

Admission Criteria: *Note: completing the courses on the addendums below does not guarantee admission to the UC BS Substance Abuse Counseling program.

Minimum GPA: 2.00

BS Completion: Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

Admission Period: Cuyahoga Community College students must be admitted to the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between July 2021 and April 2023).

Agreement Execution Date: July 2021

Agreement End Date: April 2023

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its approval of both institutions and will remain effective for the duration of the **Transfer Pathways Completion Articulation Agreement** (Institutional Agreement). At the end of this time, the Transfer Degree Map will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Cuyahoga Community College and the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice and Human Services agree to keep one another informed as program curricular changes affecting this Transfer Degree Map (program articulation agreement) occur and will be reviewed on an annual basis. Both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.


As strong partners, Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) Human Services program agrees to provide direct access to AAS Human Services: Alcohol/Chemical Dependency Option students in the last semester of their degree program to a University of Cincinnati representative **upon request when possible**. This could be in the form of a classroom visit or other opportunities to directly interact and educate students about the Substance Abuse Counseling Online program at the University of Cincinnati. Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) Human Services Program also agrees to provide a graduation list with emails **upon request when possible**. The University of Cincinnati College of Education, Criminal Justice, & Human Services will provide success rates of incoming cohorts of Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) AAS Human Services: Alcohol/Chemical Dependency Option students upon request as able.
