- Completion of the courses on this worksheet does not guarantee admission to the UC BA Psychology program.
- Students who complete the AA Psychology at Columbus State Community College have satisfied the UC General Education requirement.
- BA Completion: Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation. If a student plans to complete the degree 100% online, they must have sixty-one (61) applicable credit hours before matriculation. Students without 61 applicable hours should speak with an admissions representative or an advisor about options.
- Admission Period: Students must be admitted to the UC College of Arts & Sciences during the duration of this agreement.
- Minimum GPA: 2.0.
