

Be it resolved that the Faculty Senate endorses the following resolutions and motion put forward by the College of Applied Science.

February 9, 2009

The attached three resolutions and one motion were unanimously approved by the College of Applied Science (CAS) Faculty at our monthly faculty meeting held Thursday, February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009. The resolutions are a result of the faculty's desire for the restructuring planning process to be highly inclusive of faculty given the impact the changes will have upon the professional lives of the faculty.

Resolution 1

It is resolved that the faculty of the College of Engineering (CoE) and the College of Applied Science (CAS) should make up a majority of the CAS/COE subcommittee of the Collegiate Re-structuring Steering Committee (CRSC), including at least one representative from each of the colleges' re-structuring committees. These members are to be elected by the faculty of the colleges they represent.

Resolution 2

It is resolved that the faculty of the Center for Access and Transition (CAT) should make up a majority of the CAT subcommittee of the Collegiate Re-structuring Steering Committee (CRSC), including at least one representative from the CAT's re-structuring committee and one representative from each of the math and humanities departments. These members are to be elected by the faculty of the CAT.

Resolution 3

It is resolved that the College of Applied Science (CAS), College of Engineering (CoE) and the Center for Access and Transition (CAT) should each have representation on the Collegiate Re-structuring Steering Committee equal to that of other affected colleges named in the CRSC subcommittees. Further, be it resolved that the CAS representatives be split between the technical departments and the support departments and the CAT representatives be split between the math and humanities departments.

Motion

It is moved that the College of Applied Science faculty recommend that faculty co-chairs instead of faculty vice chairs serve on each of the subcommittees of the Collegiate Re-structuring Steering Committee (CRSC) and on the CRSC itself.
