

The Learning Assistance Center offers free tutoring for all UC students at our office in French Hall 2441.

- One-on-one sessions take place with a trained, subject-specific tutor.
- More than 300 courses are supported.

Supplemental Instruction (SI) is a series of free, weekly review sessions for students in historically difficult courses.
