

**3361: 50-55-18 McMicken college of arts and sciences: academic probation, suspension and dismissal.**

- (A) Probation action will be taken at the conclusion of each quarter of the regular academic year. Terminal action (suspension and dismissal) will be taken only at the end of each spring quarter.
- (B) A student incurs probation at the end of any quarter in which he/she has earned a quarter-term and/or cumulative quality point average of less than 2.0. Thereafter, the student will be continued on probation until such time as he/she is reinstated to good standing or is suspended or dismissed.
- (C) Suspension occurs when:
  - (1) The student's spring quarter average is less than 0.80;
  - (2) The student incurring or continuing probation at the end of the autumn quarter fails to remove probation by the end of the spring quarter;
  - (3) The student has a cumulative quality point deficiency exceeding eighteen quality points below the number needed for a 2.0 cumulative quality point average by the end of the spring quarter.

A suspended student is denied registration privileges for at least one academic year. Reinstatement after suspension is not automatic, but may be granted after the suspension period has elapsed and the student has successfully applied for readmission. If readmission is granted, the student will return to the college on probation, and must then remove his/her probation by the end of the next spring quarter.
- (D) Dismissal results when a student who has been suspended once earns grades such as to warrant a second suspension. Dismissal constitutes a final and permanent separation from the college of arts and sciences. Readmission of a dismissed student will not be considered.
- (E) A probationary student who withdraws or fails to register for the following quarter is subject to the same regulations and readmission procedures as a suspended student.
